ELIGIBILITY

- For women enrolling in an academic program leading to certification or licensure in a trade or vocation
- Students must be enrolling full time (12 units or more), plan to complete the assigned program of study and have a GPA of 2.5 or greater.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The scholarship application will be evaluated based on a variety of factors, including, but not limited to:

1. Financial need
2. Career goal and plan
3. Content of essay
4. Leadership qualities
5. Scholastic achievement
6. Community service

ATTACH THE FOLLOWING TO YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION:

1. A written recommendation from a college administrator, counselor or instructor.
2. A current transcript (or most recent) transcript of academic work completed.
3. A typewritten, one-page (maximum) essay discussing reasons for selecting your field of study and how school, community or work experiences have influenced your choice. Mention your background, awards, recognitions and reasons why you should receive this scholarship.

SELECTION PROCESS AND DEADLINE

Completed application **MUST** be received on or before **March 31, 2017**.

Applicants may be required to meet with the scholarship committee for an oral interview and recipients will be invited to a Soroptimist luncheon for the presentation of the scholarship.
